## Minutes of the Lanes Cove Historic Association (LCHA) November 5, 2022

**Location:** The meeting was held in the Big Shack.

Other items mentioned to discuss next March were upkeep of the gardens and perhaps replacing the flower boat that is in disrepair, the stairs that the City still has not repaired, and the need to putty the windows in the small shack.

With a motion made and seconded, Ralph adjourned the meeting at 10:30.
